Types of Injury

When the Type of Victim is an Individual or Law Enforcement Officer for one or more of the following offenses, a Type of Injury must be entered for each victim.



Applicable offenses:

Aggravated Assault

Extortion / Blackmail

Fondling

Human Trafficking Offenses

Kidnapping / Abduction

Rape

Robbery

Sexual Assault with an Object

Simple Assault

Sodomy

Allowed Entries: (Up to five may be entered per victim)

Apparent Broken Bones = B

Apparent Minor Injury = M

Loss of Teeth = T

None = N

Other Major Injury = O

Possible Internal Injury = I

Severe Laceration = L

Unconsciousness = U

Acceptable Injury Types for Simple Assault include "Apparent Minor Injury" or "None".

All Injury Types are applicable to Aggravated Assault except for "Apparent Minor Injury".
