NIBRS Submission of Domestic Violence

Washington State Domestic Violence Definitions (RCW 26.50.010):

"Domestic violence" means:

(a) Physical harm, bodily injury, assault, or the infliction of fear of imminent physical harm, bodily injury or assault, between family or household members;

(b) sexual assault of one family or household member by another; or

(c) stalking as defined in RCW 9A.46.110 of one family or household member by another family or household member.

"Family or household members" means:

For NIBRS Purposes: The Domestic Violence indicator must be answered for all offenses of Crimes Against Persons, Robbery, Burglary, Larceny, Motor Vehicle Theft, and Arson; for all other offenses, this field should remain blank.
