Reporting Vehicular Homicide

As of January 1, 2019, incidents of Vehicular Homicide can be submitted as a Group A Negligent Manslaughter offense when DUI, distracted driving, or reckless driving are involved.

 The definition of Negligent Manslaughter (09B) now includes the killing of another person associated with driving under the influence, distracted driving (using a cell or smartphone), and reckless driving fatalities.



- The Type of Weapon/Force Involved data element should be "Motor Vehicle/Vessel".
- If the incident was a result of distracted driving, the Offender Suspected of Using data element should be "Computer Equipment (Handheld Devices)".
