Introduction to Communication Technologies for Law Enforcement

This course introduces students to the basic understanding of communication technologies. This course use lectures to describe cellphone communication architecture, cellphone geolocation, IP address, online communication, and strategies and tips in analyzing communication. The class will teach students how to read, analyze, and interpret communication data and inform the latest updates on iOS/Android that would affect LE investigation. This course is for those with little or no experience/understanding in how certain communication technology works. Upon course completion, students will have a better understanding of how different types of communication technology work and some ideas for improving their performance as a LE officer when handling and investigating communication devices.
