POLICE OFFICER - LATERAL

The Winlock Police Department is currently accepting applications for a full time Lateral Police Officer. The positions will be open until filled. Applicants must have worked on a full-time basis for at least 12 months of the last 24 months as a commissioned Law Enforcement Officer. Post-Police Academy Graduates will be considered.

Applicants must also have a current Washington State Criminal Justice Training Commission Basic Law Enforcement Academy Certificate or equivalent certification from another state-approved academy with an understanding they must achieve certification by the Washington State Equivalency Academy within one year of employment. Benefits include retirement, family healthcare (medical, dental, vision), vacation, sick leave, and Teamsters Union membership. **Wages start at \$33.00 hourly** with increases already negotiated.
