## KIRKLAND POLICE CHIEF CHERIE HARRIS ELECTED TO EXECUTIVE BOARD OF STATEWIDE LAW ENFORCMENT ORGANIZATION

(Lacey) --- Kirkland Police Chief Cherie Harris was named Chief At-Large of the board of the Washington Association of Sheriffs and Police Chiefs (WASPC). Chief Harris was appointed to fill a vacancy.
