(flu like symptoms plus an additional element of concern – ie: travel or known contact with a COVID-19 patient)



Member can remain in service – all equipment is decontaminated


Follow department policy on exposure reporting.

(flu like symptoms plus an additional element of concern - ie: travel or known contact with a COVID-19 patient)






ollow department policy on exposure reporting.

Employee remains on paid leave until cleared to return to work.



Department works to identify and confirm work related exposure
